

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Monday 06 Jul 2015

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Turning wet and breezy from the southwest, with locally heavy rain across western hills. East and southeast England, north and east Scotland will be mostly dry with some sunshine, although isolated showers are possible in northern Scotland later. Patchy rain in the west moves eastwards overnight, becoming heavy later. Rain also moves northwards across Scotland. Dry, but cloudy elsewhere.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Heavy showery rain will clear southeast England through the morning. Outbreaks of rain will persist across northern Scotland. Elsewhere, there will be variable cloud with sunny spells and scattered showers. Remaining unsettled on Wednesday and cooler, with sunshine and fewer showers.
