Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :
In most regions, a very frosty start will bring some icy and treacherous travelling conditions during the morning.
Otherwise, much of England and Wales will be cold and dry with sunny periods. However, a few sleet or snow showers are expected near the East Anglian coast and also towards Irish sea coasts.
Meanwhile in Scotland and Northern Ireland, after a mostly bright start, it will turn cloudy and less cold with some rain or sleet, although with snow on hills.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Central and northern Scotland will have sleet or snow, but other regions should turn milder with rain at times.
