Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Showery rain across southern England will clear southwards this morning, then this area will be dry and generally sunny. Elsewhere, there will be sunny spells, but also wintry showers. Some of these will be heavy with hail and thunder, and will bring temporary snow cover to some places, especially for northern hills. It will be rather cold, and in the north, windy.

Tonight, showers will persist across northern Scotland. Elsewhere, it will become dry, clear and frosty.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

Sunday will be a day of sunshine and heavy wintry showers, some with hail, snow and thunder. Monday will be mostly dry with some sunshine, but rain, wind and rising temperatures will reach northwestern areas later.
