

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Much of England will be dry this morning but becomes progressively cloudier with rain spreading from the west to affect most places overnight. Scotland and Wales will be generally cloudy with rain affecting western areas this morning becoming more widespread today before gradually easing overnight. Northern Ireland will have rain this morning but becomes drier today with only showers tonight.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Occasional rain or showers for much of the UK over the weekend, with the chance of more frequent showers for Scotland and Northern Ireland on Saturday. Southeast England is likely to be driest and sunniest. Temperatures at or above average.
