Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :  
Northern Ireland, and much of Scotland, will be dry once early rain  
has cleared. Generally it will be rather cloudy but some brighter  
spells are likely. Much of England and Wales will see outbreaks of  
rain, sleet and some snow for a time, even to low levels in central  
and eastern areas, but it should gradually become dry in most parts.  
The far southeast of England will remain dry throughout. Feeling cold  
in many places.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:  
Generally dry on Sunday but rain reaching some western districts  
during the day. Rain across southern parts of the UK on Monday, dry  
elsewhere.
