

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 1945 on Sunday 09 Mar 2008

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:  
Heavy rain across much of the United Kingdom at first on Monday morning, clearing away eastwards across England but becoming slow moving over Northern Ireland and Scotland with some hill snow. Further rain or squally heavy showers over England and Wales from mid morning. Severe gales or storms, with potentially damaging gusts, will mainly affect southern parts of Britain.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

The very unsettled conditions will continue with further spells of heavy and persistent rain, interspersed by more showery interludes with clear or sunny spells. It will remain generally windy with gales, occasionally severe gales, these mainly affecting western coasts and hills.
