Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:  
Rain, possibly turning to hill snow, in northern and eastern areas should gradually become confined to Scotland. Sunny intervals should develop over much of the remainder of England, Wales and Northern Ireland, with scattered, heavy showers, especially in the southwest. Some of these may turn thundery at times. Winds should be mainly light from the south or southeast.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Rather cloudy and mostly dry with a few bright or sunny spells developing locally. The odd spot of drizzle is possible too. Southeasterly winds are expected to strengthen in western parts on Sunday afternoon, and rain may just reach the far southwest.
