

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Heavy showery rain over northern Scotland will ease with brighter spells developing through the course of today. Elsewhere will see spells of warm sunshine and a few light showers, although northeast England may catch a heavier one. Showers will largely clear from Scotland overnight leaving most places dry, but isolated light showers are expected to continue in places.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Scattered showers will develop during Tuesday, affecting central and western parts of the UK in particular. However, some persistent rain may graze southeast England later. Many places will be dry on Wednesday but showers are expected for the northwest of the UK.
