

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 0700 on Sunday 08 May 2011

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Any heavy rain across northern parts will quickly clear, to be replaced by a mixture of sunshine and showers. It will be a fresher feeling day, with a southerly breeze. Overnight most of the showers will die away, although one or two may linger until dawn in the west.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Monday will see further sunshine and showers, although the showers are likely to be heavier and more widespread than on Sunday. Tuesday will then be mostly dry, although some showers are still likely, mainly in the northwest. The southerly wind will persist on both days and temperatures will be around average.
