Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
There will be some good sunny spells today but also occasional showers. These will be heaviest and most frequent in Scotland and Northeast England, but only light elsewhere. Rain will spread into Southwest England this evening, and across Wales the Midlands and Southeast England overnight.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:  
Wednesday will be a wet day across Wales, and Central and Southern England with periods of heavy rain. Further north the rain should be light and intermittent with some parts staying dry. Thursday will be a showery day in all parts with some more persistent rain in Northern Scotland.
