Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Plenty of dry, cold conditions with sunny spells. Heavy snow showers, some prolonged, will affect N.Ireland, southwest Scotland and northeast Scotland with significant snow accumulations likely. Cloudy over southern England. Snow reaching north Wales and northwest England later this afternoon, possibly giving significant snow accumulations, will become less intense as it pushes southeast overnight. Snow showers continuing over northern Scotland. Elsewhere clear and frosty.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Many places will start cold and frosty, then be dry and sunny over the weekend. Further snow showers are likely though, mainly over northern Scotland, with some across N.Ireland, north Wales and North Sea coasts too.
