Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
A rather cloudy start for most parts, with some light rain across northern Scotland and Northern Ireland. As the day progresses sunshine should develop across many southern and western parts of the UK. Overnight, cloud will spread west once again, although it is likely to be cold, with patchy frost and fog in places.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:  
It will remain generally dry, if rather dull and cloudy. It will also stay chilly, with a continuing risk of overnight frost and fog. Winds will be generally light and variable in direction, although it will be breezy along the south coast of England at first.
