

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Sunday 08 Mar 2015

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Cool with sunny spells and scattered showers across Scotland and Northern Ireland at first. Often cloudy elsewhere, with early rain across Wales and northwest England spreading slowly southeast, and easing. Drier, brighter weather follows from the northwest with winds easing, then mostly dry this evening with lengthy clear spells allowing a frost to develop.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Bright but chilly to start in the east on Monday. Turning wet and windy with the risk of severe gales in the north and northwest, but breezy with more patchy rain across the south. A chilly start on Tuesday, then a largely fine and dry day.
