

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Sunday 05 Dec 2010

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rain will clear southern counties of England whilst snow showers affect northern Scotland and wintry showers affect coastlines exposed to northerly winds elsewhere. Otherwise dry with some sunny spells. Sleet and snow then spread south overnight affecting the northern half of the UK with England and Wales staying mainly dry. Icy roads and freezing fog are a risk.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

The sleet and snow continue south but ease whilst further sleet and snow showers affect northern Scotland and exposed coasts into Tuesday. Southern UK stays mostly dry with some sunshine, but there is an ongoing risk of freezing fog and icy roads.
