

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Sunday 22 Nov 2015

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
It will be a cold and locally icy start with scattered wintry showers. The showers will ease from the west today allowing increasingly sunny conditions to develop. It will feel less cold due to lighter winds. Showers will die out in the east overnight to leave most parts dry and clear. It will turn frosty with patchy ice and fog.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Wet and windy, albeit milder weather will spread southeast across Scotland and Northern Ireland on Monday, reaching northern England and Wales later. Elsewhere it will be bright, but chilly. Rain will clear southeastwards on Tuesday, leaving sunshine and blustery showers.
