

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Saturday 09 May 2009

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rain, often heavy, will move across Northern Ireland and southern Scotland, then northern England and Wales this afternoon. Showers will follow, some heavy and thundery across Scotland. Further south mainly dry and bright. Temperatures close to normal across the UK. Overnight rain will continue across Wales and central England, remaining areas generally dry as showers mostly die away across Scotland.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

Sunday outbreaks of rain across Wales and parts of northern England, further south staying mostly dry and bright, while scattered showers develop across Northern Ireland and Scotland. Monday many places dry and fine with some sunny spells, although becoming windy.
