Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:

A dull start for many places, but cloud should thin and lift to leave a largely dry day with some bright and sunny spells. The odd shower may develop in the north during the afternoon. Cloud will thicken from the west, and some rain may affect Northern Ireland during the evening.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Rain spreads into Scotland, Wales and western England during Tuesday morning, but brighter in the east before cloud builds later. Remaining unsettled through Wednesday with rain affecting all areas, this could be heavy in the northwest with a risk of gales. Rain may ease later in the southwest.
