Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
A frosty start across much of the UK. A largely dry day is expected with plenty of sunny spells, especially in the south. However, it will generally be cloudier towards the northeast with the risk of a few light wintry showers. Brisk easterly winds in the south. A widespread sharp frost returning overnight.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:  
Remaining cold and largely dry with variable amounts of cloud. The risk of scattered snow flurries developing at times across southeast England on Wednesday and perhaps again on Thursday. The best of the sunny spells probably over central and western areas, Still breezy, especially in the south.
