Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Some bright or sunny spells. However, there will be showers, a few probably heavy and with wintry showers on the higher northern hills. Showers will merge into a spell of more general rain by this evening, the rain crossing many places overnight but always heaviest over western districts. Windy, too, with gales or even severe gales possible.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Showers affecting much of southern Britain on Tuesday, from about the Midlands southwards, and also the far northwest of Scotland. Elsewhere, mainly dry and bright. A spell of rain for many southwestern parts on Wednesday but mainly dry elsewhere.
