



National Severe Weather Warning Service



Chief Forecasters Assessment

A very cold airmass is still covering southern Britain. A frontal system just to the south may bring some further showery outbreaks of sleet or snow, but amounts seem likely to be quite small.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Warning of Ice**

Valid from **00:05 on Mon, 21st Jan 2013** until **23:59 on Mon, 21st Jan 2013**

Icy stretches are expected to affect parts of southern UK at times during Monday and to develop more widely again on Monday evening especially where snow has partially melted by day or where any further rain, sleet or snow has occurred.

There is the risk of further localised snowfalls of some 1-3 cm in places during Monday, more particularly in the extreme southeast later.

The public should be aware of the risk of disruption to travel during this continuing spell of wintry weather.
