

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Brisk northeasterly winds will bring sleet or snow showers to some eastern coasts. Otherwise, dry, sunny but cold. Tonight, a widespread frost developing, quite sharp in places. Staying dry in the south but becoming wet and windy in the north, rain turning to snow for a time in Scotland and on hills in northern England.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Mostly cloudy with rain, with hill snow at first, edging south, becoming light and sporadic. Brighter, showery in north later. Windy and feeling cold, especially in cloudier south. Sunday, sunny spells and isolated showers, winds easing down. Rain reaching northwestern areas later.
