Headline:

Some hazy sunshine. Rain or sleet in east clearing

This Evening and Tonight:

Rain with some hill snow in the north and east, gradually becoming confined to eastern and some central areas later. Largely dry further west with clear spells. Frosty in the Highlands.

Friday:

Patchy rain/sleet over eastern and some central areas dying away then most parts dry with some hazy sunshine. Isolated wintry showers possible in the southeast with rain in the far northwest later. Rather cold.

Outlook for Saturday:

Starting bright and frosty over England and East Wales. Light rain/sleet in the north may edge southwards into England and Wales before becoming light and patchy. Rather cold.
