

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rain and snow will continue across Wales and central England with very strong winds. Clearer in the north with ice patches at first, followed by wintry showers. Further south, showers may turn wintry over western hills. Frosty in the north overnight, although cloud and rain will push into Scotland. Elsewhere rain and hill snow move slowly south.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

A frosty start generally, followed by sunny spells. Rain and hill snow in the southwest should slowly clear in the afternoon. Cloudier with rain in Scotland and Northern Ireland. Mostly cloudy on Friday, with some rain although some bright spells in the south.
