

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Rain gradually clearing northeastwards, but likely lingering across some northeastern parts until evening. Sunshine and showers following elsewhere. However, some heavy, squally showers with hail and thunder will move eastwards across England and Wales. Windy. Variable cloud and clear spells overnight with blustery showers, most frequent in the west. Further rain in the southwest later.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

A dry start for most Saturday, but rain, locally heavy, in the southwest will move north-eastwards across England and Wales during the day. Brighter conditions with showers following. Drier and brighter with lighter winds Sunday, with scattered, locally heavy, showers in the south and west.
