Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Scotland, Northern Ireland and northern England will be mostly cloudy with rain or drizzle at times, chiefly in the west and north. The rain should die out from the south later. Elsewhere, it will be dry with some sunshine, particularly in the east. Mild, and very mild in the north. Strong winds over the north decreasing.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Mostly dry but cloudy on Thursday, with some sunshine likely in places, especially the east. A little rain will spread southeastwards on Friday, followed by good spells of sunshine. It will become cooler, though still mild in most places. Windy in the north.
