Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Rather cloudy and showery this morning, with some heavy rain and strong winds over southern England. Sunny spells and blustery, sometimes heavy and squally, showers will push eastwards this afternoon. More persistent rain is possible over northwestern parts. Gales will develop over exposed western parts. Cloud and showers dying away this evening. Largely dry overnight, but windy, with gales moving east over northern parts.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Mostly dry with sunny spells on Saturday although some rain will spread over N.Ireland and western Scotland. Breezy. Largely fine on Sunday too, but rain will spread in over western parts in the afternoon. Rather warm.
