

Forecast For The United Kingdom
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Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Cloudy start across eastern Scotland and England, but this should soon burn back to the North Sea coast. Otherwise another mostly fine day with plenty of warm sunshine, but cooler near coasts and some showers developing in the north. Showers dying away this evening, then most places dry and largely clear overnight. Perhaps some fog patches forming towards dawn.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:
Remaining fine and mainly dry for most, with plenty of warm sunshine and generally light winds. Patchy cloud may affect North Sea coasts at times and isolated showers are likely to develop in the far south and also across northern parts.

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
