Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :
Southeast England will start dry, but with patchy frost and fog.
However, this will clear as outbreaks of rain or drizzle across the
rest of England and Wales move southeastwards. Dry and fairly sunny
weather, already across Scotland and Northern Ireland will edge
southeastwards across much of Wales and England during the day, but
southeastern areas will remain dull and rather damp until after dark.
Temperatures will be near average.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:
Wednesday will be sunny for most after a frosty start. However,
rather cloudy and colder weather across southern areas will spread
northwestwards to many places during Thursday, bringing a little
light rain or sleet.
