Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Scotland and Northern Ireland will be cloudy with outbreaks of rain or drizzle. This will tend to peter out from the west during the afternoon. After a frosty start most of England and Wales should have a fine morning. Showers will develop again for a time, particularly inland.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Another unsettled day with showery outbreaks of rain for Friday. Parts of eastern and southeastern England though should stay dry. Saturday stays changeable with a mixture of sunshine and showers. The showers are likely to be locally heavy and it will be breezy in the north and west.
