Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
A rather cloudy day for most with light winds and outbreaks of rain across western, northern and some southern coastal areas. Drier, brighter spells are expected to the southeast and in the far north of Scotland. Rain may become more persistent across Scotland through the evening and overnight, perhaps turning wintry on hills.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Friday will be largely cloudy, with outbreaks of rain in the north and bright spells in the south. Heavier, more persistent rain should spread east on Friday night and Saturday, giving some snow on northern hills and strengthening southeasterly winds. Brighter conditions follow from the west later.
