Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
Fine, dry and warm with sunny spells and light winds across England and Wales. Cloud and rain will spread eastwards across Scotland and N.Ireland during today with showers following. That rain will push southeast over much of England and Wales tonight with showers over western Scotland, and mainly dry in N.Ireland and eastern Scotland.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:  
Showery rain will clear from Kent on Wednesday morning. Sunny spells and showers elsewhere, with those showers becoming increasingly isolated. Dry and warm with sunny spells in southern England on Thursday. A mixture of sunny spells and blustery showers, locally heavy, elsewhere. Temperatures around normal.
