

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 0700 on Wednesday 06 Feb 2013

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Outbreaks of rain, sleet and hill snow in places this morning will move south, leaving sunny spells in the afternoon. Scattered wintry showers in northern Scotland and eastern Britain, and more isolated showers around western coasts, will continue today and into the night. Otherwise a mainly clear, cold and frosty night is expected with strong winds easing through the evening.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Rain, sleet and hill snow will gradually spread into the west on Thursday. Eastern and central areas remain mostly dry and bright, with coastal showers easing. Wintry outbreaks will edge eastwards into Friday, largely petering out before reaching the southeast.
