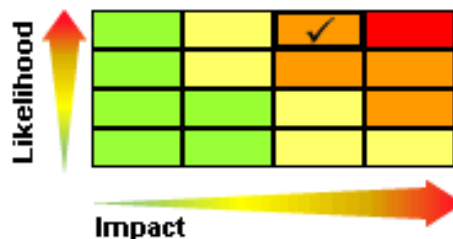
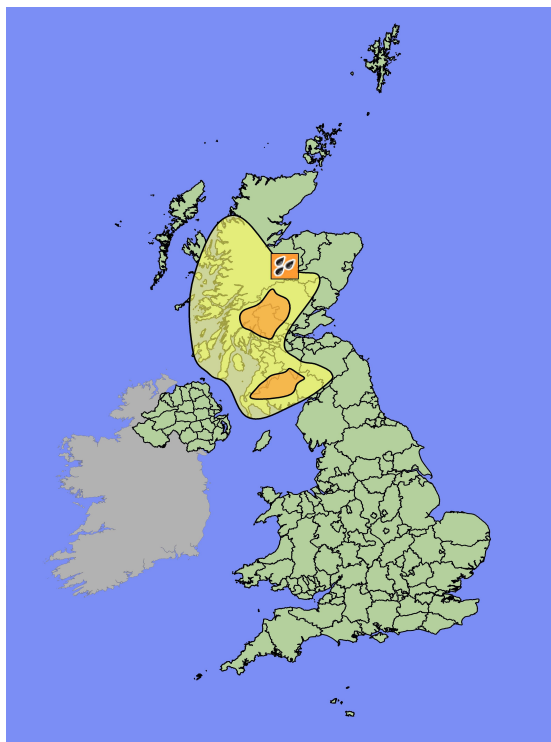




National Severe Weather Warning Service



Chief Forecasters Assessment

A slow moving cold front will bring persistent and often heavy rain to western parts of Scotland during Monday night and Tuesday. 20 to 40 mm of rain is expected to fall widely with 50 to 75 mm over the higher parts of Dumfries and Galloway and the South and West Highlands, perhaps locally 80-100 mm in the wettest spots. Gales may become severe in the southwest on Tuesday morning with gusts of 60 to 70 mph.

The Met Office have issued an **Amber Warning of Rain**

Valid from **00:00 on Tue, 29th Nov 2011** until **16:00 on Tue, 29th Nov 2011**

Rain will become heavy and persistent on Monday night and will last well into Tuesday. This will fall onto already saturated ground, leading to the risk of localised flooding and some travel disruption. The rain will be accompanied by strengthening southerly winds, with severe gales likely in the southwest during Tuesday morning. The rain will clear from the west later in the afternoon.
