

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Apart from drizzle mainly near western coasts and hills, much of the UK will be dry and mild though mostly cloudy. Some bright or sunny intervals are likely mainly in the south and east. Tonight, rain at times in the north, but Scotland and Northern Ireland dry and clear later. Wales, central and southern England cloudy, mild and mainly dry.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Friday, rain across southeastern areas soon clearing then most areas dry and sunny with light winds but quickly turning chilly in the evening under clear skies. Saturday, most parts dry and sunny with light winds but a sharp frost overnight.
