Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Friday:-northeastern areas of the UK will dawn bright and frosty,
while southern parts will start damp and cloudy. Rain/drizzle will
reach the west this morning and spread eastwards across many areas
this afternoon with some hill snow for Scotland later. Temperatures,
near normal, becoming mild in the south and west.
Friday evening/night:-Cloudy with occasional rain or drizzle, heavy
for a time, with hill snow over Highland Scotland.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:
Bright or sunny after clearance of rain from southeast England.
Showers following to the north and northwest of the UK, turning
wintry with temporary blizzards as winds increase gale / severe gale
force.
Feeling cold in the winds. Frosty by night
