Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
The wintry weather continues with further snow for parts of the UK. Heavy snow will affect the south throughout the day, easing as it clears southeastwards overnight. Elsewhere, snow showers will continue for much of the day, although more western parts may become dry for a time with some sunshine. It becomes very cold overnight with widespread frost and ice.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

It remains very cold on Thursday and Friday with further outbreaks of snow expected, mainly in northern and eastern parts but possible anywhere. It will be very cold during the night with a continuing risk of ice and frost throughout.
