

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Sunny spells and scattered showers generally today, with some heavy and thundery downpours likely. Mostly cloudy with persistent rain over western Scotland. Breezy in the south, with temperatures around normal, but locally warm in any sunny spells. Some late sunny spells this evening, then mostly rather cloudy with some showery rain overnight. Probably driest in the east. Mild.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:
Cloudy with further rain for northeastern parts on Tuesday. Rain over southern England should clear in the morning, but otherwise a mixture of sunny spells and showers, some heavy, is expected. Wednesday will see sunny intervals and blustery, sometimes heavy, showers.
