Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :
Rain, heavy at times, over much of Scotland and England will soon clear away and the strong to gale force winds will decrease a little. Showers in the west will sweep across many districts as southwesterly gales develop again across Wales, northern England, then Northern Ireland and southern Scotland. Some showers will be heavy, perhaps with hail and thunder.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Monday, rain and gales over Scotland moving slowly north and moderating. Showers elsewhere giving way to rain, with strong winds in south. Tuesday, strong winds, with gales around southern coasts, and squally showers, particularly in west and north. Feeling noticeably colder.
