Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Occasional heavy rain in England and Wales will move steadily eastwards during the day, leaving drier, brighter weather in the west with a few showers. Meanwhile, some scattered heavy showers are expected for Scotland and Northern Ireland. Overnight, it should become much drier across most of the country, but with some showers still affecting northwest Scotland.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

A bright day for most during Thursday with some sunshine, occasional cloud and scattered showers, these mainly in northern and eastern England and Scotland. Another wet and breezy day on Friday, with the rain reaching eastern England later in the day.
