Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :
Patchy mist or fog will quickly clear, then most places will have a dry start with some sunshine. However, scattered showers, already across northern and western Scotland will develop elsewhere, a few of these heavy, especially from the Midlands and North Wales northwards. Most southern areas, however, should remain dry, especially near coasts where the day should remain sunny. Temperatures near normal, but it should feel warm in sunshine and light winds.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:
Sunshine and showers in the north. However, southern England and perhaps Wales will become very windy with heavy, perhaps thundery rain and here it will feel very chilly.
