

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 0700 on Friday 27 Nov 2015

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Becoming windier as a band of rain, locally heavy and squally, moves
southeastwards during the day. Meanwhile, ahead of this, mild with a few sunny
intervals, mainly to the east of high ground, generally cloudy with patchy light
rain and drizzle in places. Turning colder in the north, with blustery showers,
these turning wintry over northern hills.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Mainly unsettled during the weekend, with blustery showers or longer spells of
rain for many. The showers turning increasingly wintry in the north,
particularly over higher ground. It will be quite windy at times, with gales or
severe gales in places.
