Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Cloud and drizzle will clear southern England this morning, giving way to warm spells of sunshine through the rest of the day. Elsewhere will have a bright day with variable cloud and some sunshine, but also a scattering of showers. Staying mostly dry overnight with clear spells.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

After a chilly start, Sunday looks set to be fine with plenty of warm sunny spells and light winds. However, thicker cloud is expected in the far west later on. Turning unsettled on Monday with rain or showers for most, though southeast England should remain dry with some warm sunshine.
