

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 0700 on Saturday 16 May 2009

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Generally becoming windy with sunshine and showers across the UK today, although rain across northern Scotland will gradually clear away northwards. The showers will be heaviest, perhaps with thunder, and most frequent across western parts, where the wind may gust to gale force. Temperatures near or just below average. Tonight much of England becoming dry, elsewhere further showers or rain.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Sunday showers or periods of rain, sometimes heavy, especially across northern and western parts. Southeast England and East Anglia will be the driest, while generally becoming less windy. Monday sunshine and showers across the UK. Both days temperatures near normal.
