Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Sunny spells and scattered showers in most places with the far southeast staying driest and brightest. The showers will fall as snow across the high ground in the north, particularly in Scotland. It will be another chilly day ahead of a largely dry, cold and clear night giving a frost for many.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Brighter intervals and scattered showers Wednesday, these heavy at times. Cloud and rain will spread into northwestern parts during the evening, but it will be another cold night elsewhere with a frost risk. The rain will turn showery as it moves east on Thursday allowing some brightness too.
