Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
A grey and misty start with a slight frost, along with patchy fog. However, frost and fog should clear, then most places will be dry with variable cloud and some bright spells. Western Scotland will remain grey and damp with a little drizzle. It will remain cold.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:
Frost and patchy fog clearing slowly, then Friday will be dry and cold with some sunshine, though northwest Scotland will be milder. Frosty again Friday night, then much of England remaining dry with some sunshine Saturday. However, rain, strong winds and milder temperatures will spread to all other areas during the day.
