

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Thursday 04 Aug 2011

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A dry start across some northern and eastern areas, but outbreaks of rain elsewhere moving northeast with brighter conditions following. Risk of thundery showers across eastern England and Northern Ireland this afternoon, but these soon clearing this evening and rain in north Scotland easing too. Patchy drizzle over northwestern hills, but most parts dry overnight with clear spells. Feeling fresher.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Most parts having a dry day on Friday with partly cloudy skies and sunny intervals, especially around the coasts. A few showers developing across northwestern Britain, although these mainly light. Similar on Saturday, but more showers, occasionally heavy and thundery.
