

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Monday 24 Mar 2008

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Morning rain will continue in Northern Ireland, Wales and southwest England, clearing later. Elsewhere, a frosty and in places icy start is likely, with further sleet or snow showers about the northeast and east coast, sometimes heavy in the far north. Frost will redevelop in places overnight.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Further snow showers are likely about the northeast and east coasts on Tuesday, mainly morning, heavy in the far northeast. Rain will fall in some western parts, increasing later, otherwise it will be mainly dry with sunny spells. On Wednesday, rain will extend through much of Britain, with Scotland remaining mostly dry.
