Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:  
Friday will be another cold day across the United Kingdom but most parts should be sunny throughout. The main exceptions to this are southeastern England, where snow showers will affect parts of East Anglia and Kent. It will also turn cloudier across Northern Ireland and western Scotland in the afternoon with outbreaks of rain, perhaps sleet, in places.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

The weather will turn more unsettled this weekend, with rain preceded by snow spreading southeastwards across the country on Saturday, giving a risk of significant snowfall in places. Although generally drier, further outbreaks of rain will affect some places on Sunday.
