Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :  
Monday: Showers, often heavy, prolonged with thunder, will gradually become confined to N.Scotland. Across southern areas winds will gradually ease from the west, after starting with widespread gales and locally storm force winds along exposed coasts/hills. Elsewhere windy, gales developing in exposed locations across SW.Scotland, N.Ireland and N.England.  
Feeling rather cold with the wind.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:  
Tuesday: Strong winds and rain spreading east across most of Scotland and later N.Ireland. England and Wales mainly dry, with sunny spells. Warm, locally very warm in east.

Wednesday: Windy, with rain becoming confined to north and northwest Scotland. Elsewhere mainly dry, bright/sunny spells, very warm.
