Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Cloudy across Scotland and Northern Ireland with some rain. However, drier and brighter conditions will reach many places later. Northern and western England, and much of Wales will become cloudy with patchy rain after a dry, bright morning. Southeast England and East Anglia remaining dry throughout the day with spells of sunshine and, with just a light breeze, it should not feel too bad.

Outbreaks of heavy rain spreading to remaining parts of England and Wales overnight. Drier conditions, with scattered heavy showers, across Scotland and Northern Ireland.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:
Rain or showers on both Wednesday and Thursday, especially in southern parts.
